# SafeBox Manual – English

Congratulations on your new SafeBox! Your new product has been manufactured to the highest standards, ensuring you long-lasting efficiency and safety.

**CAUTION!** Before using this product carefully read this general safety rules and instruction listed below. Before starting work, make sure that you know how to stop this reel in the event of emergency. Any other use could damage the product or cause serious injury.

Keep these instructions in a safe place and on hand so that they can be read when required Do not remove, modify, or inhibit safety devices put in a place by the manufacturer, but rather verify that they are not removed or rendered less effective.

# **GENERAL SAFETY RULES**

- 1) This product must not be used by minors or unskilled persons.
- Always check the good working order of the SafeBox which, if not adequate, could endanger the user.
- 3) Never remove any of the SafeBox's components.
- 4) Do not insert objects or place fingers on the reel aperture during rewinding
- 5) Do not leave the rope during rewinding

### INSTALLATION

Fasten the reel to the SafePass or SafeGuide using the welded bolts and provided nuts. Check that the rope returns in a straight-line with respect to the casing and make sure that it is not dragged along the sides of the opening when entering.

# Periodically:

- Check that the spring is working and that the rope is coiled properly.
- Check the rope for damages and clean it if dirty.
- Check the anchoring of the SafeBox on the Safe Solutions' SafePass, SafeGuide or wall mount.
- Do not leave the rope unreeled for long periods of time. The rope like all other ropes can be affected by long periods of sunlight over time. When left in heavy snow and freezing rain, rope may have trouble reeling. Best practices are to use the rope and store rope in its protective container until next event.

### **GUARANTEE**

**12 MONTHS** from 1<sup>st</sup> date of system start-up as stated on the packing slip. The manufacturer commits himself to carrying out, free of charge, the replacement of pieces which may result faulty because of poor material quality or defects in construction. Problems caused by incorrect use, tampering or negligence are not covered by the guarantee. Shipping charges shall be incurred by the buyer.
